All entries must be handwritten

1. Enter date
2. Enter title of article/video/class work
3. Choose required number of quotations and copy into the CPB. Keep in mind:

“A commonplace book is a way to capture the thoughts and words of those who can inspire us to new ideas”

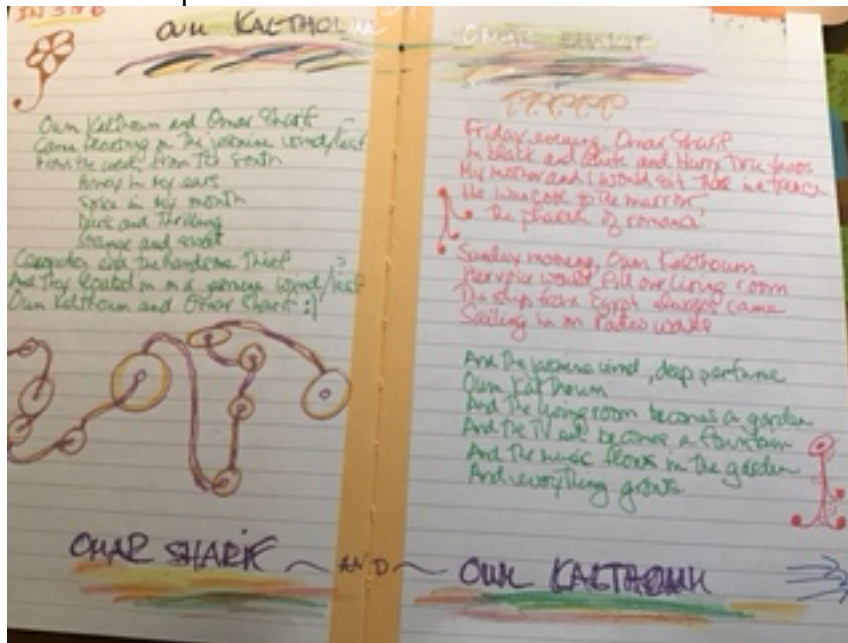
“CPB gives you an opportunity to think beyond your understanding of the world and how it functions.”
